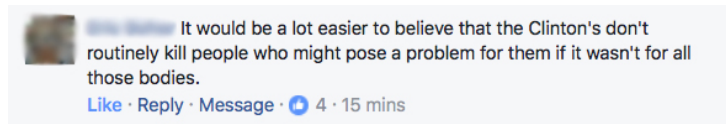


Meet Mary Caitrin Mahoney



A commenter on Facebook, upon reading my previous post wrote:

recanted, but was found guilty [Emphasis mine].

A robbery where nothing was taken?

Interesting. Sounds familiar no?

But this is the kicker:

Mahoney was shot five times, once in the back of the head, with the key to the safe in her hand. The safe, which held \$10,000, wasn't touched. Despite the Starbucks' location in a densely populated neighborhood, no one reported hearing gunfire, sparking speculation that the gunman used a silencer.

So, a safe with ten grand is left untouched ? despite the fact that Mahoney had the key in her hand.

Hmmm.

Now, for the ?interesting timing portion? of the story.
